Newsletter – Vintage 2011



The 2011 vintage is finally over!

Some of our wines are still fermenting, while the first harvested varieties started now to calm down and to get more appealing!

All the white wines varieties have been harvested at the good time to keep a good balance between acidity, aromatic maturity and sugar levels.

Regarding the red wines varieties, our Cabernet Sauvignon was the last one to be harvested last Wednesday. And this vintage reserved us some exceptional surprises!

Pinot Noir, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon are powerful, intense, balanced and very complex.

The dryness of the past two months showed us the resistance of our soil that managed to sustain our young vineyards and keep them healthy

through the harvest. The presence of clay on Dobruşa's terroir is limiting the impacts of dryness on the vines. The distress has been reduced!

Also the calcareous reflects are communicating to the grapes the needed acidity after a hot and long summer as the one of 2011.

We are also very proud to announce the launch of our Feteasca Regala 2010.

This wine reveals an expressive and complex bouquet, with some flavors of dry apricot.

The palate is very well balanced between the acidity, the roundness and the length.

This wine, due to its powerful structure, has a very good ageing potential.
